## Lao People's Democratic Republic

Summary Results of the 2021 International Comparison Program



## Size and Share in the Asia and the Pacific Region

The Summary Results for the Lao People's Democratic Republic table (Annex 1) presents purchasing power parities (PPPs), price level indexes (PLIs), estimated gross domestic product (GDP) values, and other expenditure aggregates for the Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) from the 2021 International Comparison Program (ICP). The results are based on a comparison of 21 regional economies<sup>1</sup> of Asian Development Bank that participated in the 2021 ICP for Asia and the Pacific, with Hong Kong, China as the reference economy and Hong Kong dollar (HK\$) as the reference currency for spatial comparisons. Any reference to rankings of the Lao PDR in this discussion is out of the 21 participating economies.

Among the 21 participating economies in the region, the Lao PDR's nominal GDP of HK\$148.3 billion (column 8) is the 16th largest, which is 0.07% of the region's total nominal GDP (column 9). However, the Lao PDR's real GDP is estimated higher at HK\$358.3 billion (column 3), equivalent to a larger share at 0.11% of the region's total real GDP (column 4) but maintaining its 16th place. A higher expenditure level and larger share of the region in real than in nominal terms imply that the general price level in the Lao PDR is lower than that of the reference economy (Hong Kong, China) and the region's average price level. The Lao PDR ranks 16th in both real individual consumption expenditure by households (ICEH) (HK\$170.4 billion) and nominal ICEH (HK\$69.7 billion) (columns 3 and 8) and ranks 15th in both real gross fixed capital formation (GFCF) (HK\$128.2 billion) and nominal GFCF (HK\$67.4 billion) (columns 3 and 8).

## **Per Capita Expenditures**

Accounting for the Lao PDR's population size of 7.34 million (the 15th most populous economy, or 0.19% of the region's population), the economy ranks 16th in both per capita real GDP of HK\$48,828 (column 5) and per capita nominal GDP of HK\$20,208 (column 10). The economy's per capita real ICEH (HK\$23,218) (column 5) is only 54% of the regional level, ranking 20th. Similarly, its per capita real GFCF of HK\$17,469 (column 5) is 66% of the regional level, ranking it 13th. The economy registers the lowest per capita real expenditures for the following components: oils and fats (HK\$18), clothing and footwear (HK\$255), health (HK\$1,904), and transport services (HK\$42) among the regional economies.

## **Purchasing Power Parities, Exchange Rates, and Price Levels**

With the local currency of the kip (KN), the Lao PDR's PPP at the GDP level of KN516.29 = HK\$1 is only 41% of the exchange rate of KN1,247.48 = HK\$1. This results in a PLI of 41 (Hong Kong, China = 100) (column 14), and a PLI of 64 (Asia and the Pacific = 100) (column 15), making it the 14th highest PLI in the region. The PLI for ICEH is 74 (ranking 14th), and for GFCF is 72 (ranking 11th). The Lao PDR registered the lowest PLI of 21 for the education category. <sup>2</sup>
